TREATY OF KADESH



- Signed in 1259 BC by Egyptian and Hittite empires.
- They had been at war for over 200 years.
- Rameses II invaded north in 1274 BC, was stopped at Kadesh (Syria). Ratified in 1258 BC, the 21st year of Rameses II's reign.
- The Egyptian copy was found in 1828 AD.
- The Hittite copy was found in 1906 AD.
